To remove the Win10 notification go to
Control Panel > Programs & Features

On the left top side you will see "view installed updates" Click that

In the search window (upper right side) paste KB3035583

Right click KB3035583 and click uninstall

You will have to restart your computer "

To prevent KB3035583 from reappearing, change "Windows Update" in Control Panel to "Never"

Start - Control Panel - Windows Update - Change Settings

In Important updates, click on "Never Check for Updates (not recommended)"

Then Click OK
